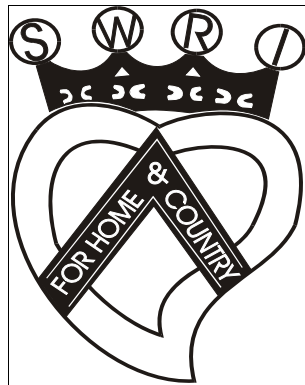

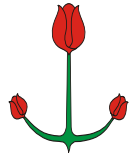
Auchenblae Over Sixties Friendship Group

The School Bus will continue to provide transport and will be at the various pick-up points starting from 10:15.

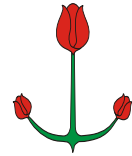
